Lechmere's Ley

Excavation work being carried out by Golden Valley Construction has revealed a 'perched water table', most likely caused by a spring. This discovery has resulted in a change to our working method whereby the large rocks we are placing at the bottom of the trench are being wrapped in a geotextile membrane to stop smaller rocks, earth, and particulates combining with the stone. This should allow water to percolate freely through the stones to limit the amount of pooling and protect the integrity of the construction.



Passing places along the temporary footpath to allow for social-distancing have been added, and vegetation growth has been cut-back.

We have received reports of cycles, and even a motorcycle being used on the walkway and would remind everyone that the footpath is for pedestrian use only and is not suitable for cycles or motorised vehicles, and kindly ask that cyclists dismount and wheel their bikes along the length of the path.
